Made with a Mission

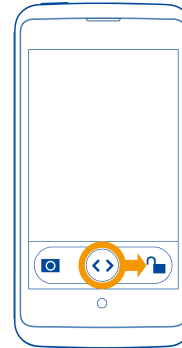

Power on



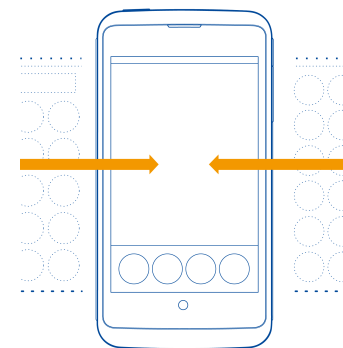
Unlock phone

Navigate Home

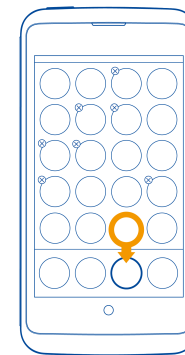
Swipe right for Everything and left for all your apps.



Personalize Home

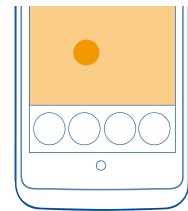
Touch and hold an icon to move or delete it. Drag icons in and out of the Dock for quick access from the Home.

Touch the Home button when you finish.



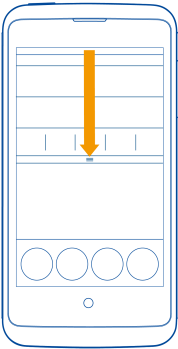
Customize wallpaper

Touch and hold the wallpaper to select a new one.



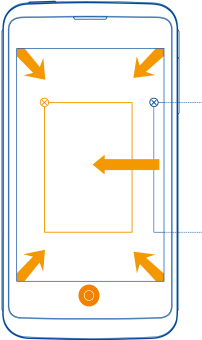
Open notifications

Touch and hold the Home button and then swipe to see other open apps. Touch an app to switch to it.



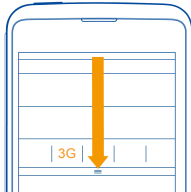
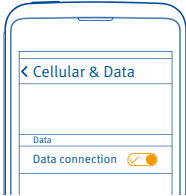
Connect to a computer
