

Switching Your Tablet to Sleep Mode Sleep Mode suspends your device to a low-power-consumption state while the display

is off to save battery power. Your device also goes into Sleep Mode automatically when you leave it idle after a certain period of time.

To quickly turn the screen off and lock the keys, press the **Power Key**.

In Sleep Mode, you will still be able to receive messages and calls.

Make a Call

TIP: To make an international call, touch and hold the 0 key to enter the plus (+) symbol. Then enter the international prefix for the country, followed by the full device number.

You can add contacts on your device and synchronize them with the contacts in your Google account or other accounts that support contact syncing.

To see your contacts, touch the **Home Key** > \bigsim > \bigsim . From there, you can touch the tabs on the top of the screen to quickly switch to the contact GROUPS or **FAVORITES** contacts.

You can use Messaging to exchange text messages (SMS). Touch the Home Kev > > Messaging, where you can create a new message, search for messages, or open an ongoing message thread.

Touch the **Home Key > ## > Email**. Use it to read and send emails from services Sound Recorder other than Gmail.

Use Browser to view web pages and search for information. Touch the **Home Key** > > Browser to start this function.

Browser also opens when you touch a web link - for example, in an email or a text customizing and configuring your device.

You can take photos and record videos. Photos and videos are stored to the device's memory card or the device's internal storage.

You can copy them to your computer or access them in the Gallery app. Touch the Home Key > ## > Camera, and touch to switch to the camcorder from the

Touch the **Home Key > ## > Gallery** to view albums of your pictures and videos.




