
Do not use the device in an enclosed environment or where heat dissipation is poor. Prolonged work in such space may cause excessive heat and raise ambient temperature, which may lead to automatic shutdown of the device for your safety. In the case of such event, cool the device in a well-ventilated place before turning on for normal use



Getting to Know Your Device

Appearance

The following figure shows the appearance of the device, it is only for your reference. The actual device may be different.



Interface and Buttons

1.Power	Hold the Power button to switch on/off the device.
2.Memory card slot	It is where you insert the memory card (microSD card).

3.WPS	This button is used to start/end Wi-Fi Protected Setup au-		
	thentication process and enable/disable the Wi-Fi function.		
	Hold it for 3 seconds to activate the WPS function.		
	When the WPS function is available, press it to deacti-		
	vate the WPS function.		
	Press it to enable/disable Wi-Fi function.		
4. OLED Screen	It indicates the signal type, signal strength, battery, Wi-Fi,		
	etc.		
5. External An-	It is used to connect an external antenna to enhance the		
tenna Connector	signal strength.		
6.Charger/USB	Charge your device.		
port	Connect the client to your device via USB cable.		

NOTES:

- microSD logo Missing is a trademark of SD Card Association.
- Hold the WPS and Power buttons simultaneously until the OLED screen turns off, and then release the buttons. The device will restart automatically and restore to the factory default settings.



Indicators

When the device is powered on, the following icons will appear on the OLED screen, with the corresponding indicates listed in the table below:

Connection Scenario

The following picture is the application example. All of the client devices can surf on the Internet at the same time.




NOTES:

- You can only use USB cable or Wi-Fi to connect this device.
- If you want to use Wi-Fi, make sure the client supports the Wi-Fi function.
- It is recommended that the operating system of your PC is Windows XP SP3
 (32 bit), Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8, or MAC (10.5 or later) client
 to connect to your device.



Installing Your Device


1. Use the thumb catch at the bottom of the device to open the battery cover.



2. Insert the SIM card into the SIM card holder.



3. Insert the battery as shown with the contacts located against the metal springs, and press the battery down into the case.




4. Line the battery cover up correctly and press gently to close the case.



- 5. Insert the microSD card.
- 1) Pull the microSD cover out of the card slot.

NOTE: Do not pull the cover rudely, as it is connected with the device.



Insert the microSD card into the microSD slot. The following picture shows
the correct inserting direction. You will hear a click when the microSD card
locks in place.



3) Close the microSD card cover.



Connecting to Your Device

Via Wi-Fi


- 1. Power on your device directly. It will take about 30 seconds to initialize.
- Use your normal Wi-Fi application on the client to search for the available wireless networks.



NOTE: Please set the client to obtain an IP address automatically referring to the chapter "Configuring your PC", and then the client will get an IP address like "192.168.1.101".



3. Select the SSID of your device, and then click Connect.



NOTE:

- Please check the label on your device to get the default SSID and Wi-Fi key.
- Double press the WPS key, and then the SSID and Wi-Fi password will display on the OLED screen.



4. Input the password, and then click Connect.



NOTE:

You may need to input the password for Wi-Fi connection, and then please check the label on your device to get the default.

5. Wait a moment, and then the client will connect to your device successfully.



Via USB Cable

1. Connect to the device.



- 2. Power on your device.
- 3. Follow the system prompts to complete the software installation.

NOTES:

- If the operating system does not launch installation automatically, you can run the installation program in path of My Computer > Glo Mobile WiFi.
 - The driver of your device will be installed at the same time.
- 4. Wait a moment, and then the client will connect to your device successfully.

Accessing the Internet

After the client connected to your device successfully, you can access the Internet in the **Automatic** or **Manual** mode. The default mode is **Automatic**.

- It is recommended that you use IE (7.0 or later), Firefox (2.0 or later), Opera (10.0 or later), Safari (4.0 or later) or Chrome (5.0 or later) to browse the webGUI configuration page.

Configuring Your PC

Follow the following steps and figures for Windows XP to configure the Internet Protocol for your Wi-Fi connection.

1. Right-click My Network Places and then select Properties.






2. Right-click Wireless Network Connection and then select Properties.





3. Select Internet Protocol(TCP/IP), and then click Properties.

Warning and Notice

To the Owner

Using Your Device

- Your device is not waterproof. Please keep it dry and store in a shady and cool place.



- Do not use your device immediately after a sudden temperature change. In such case, it will produce dew inside and outside your device, so don't use it until it becomes dry.
- Handle your device carefully. Do not drop, bend or strike it. Otherwise your device will be damaged.
- No dismantling by non-professionals and only qualified technicians can undertake repair work.
- Operating temperature range of 0°C ~ +35°C and humidity range of 5% ~ 95% are recommended.

Using Battery

- Do not short-circuit the battery, as this can cause excessive heat and fire.
- Do not store battery in hot areas or dispose of it in a fire to avoid explosion.
- Do not disassemble or modify the battery.
- When not using the battery for a long period, remove it from your device and store it in a cool dry place.
- Never use any charger or battery damaged or worn out.
