

2. After the completion of charging, disconnect the charger from the phone and AC socket.


Switching On/Off

1. Insert the lead from the charger to the socket, and connect Keypad Lock the charger to a standard wall AC socket.



PIN Code

PIN lock is on, you should enter the PIN code when powering on the handset again. The network provider offers you PIN code (four to eight digits). You should change PIN code as soon as possible for security.

If you activate Auto Keypad Lock, the keypad will be locked automatically according to your settings.

Press and hold the * **Key** to lock the keypad in standby mode. If you want to unlock the keypad, please press first the Right Soft Key, and then the * Key.

If the call is coming when the keypad is locked, you can press the Call Kev to answer.

When the keypad is locked, calls may be possible to the official emergency number programmed into your device.

Phone Code

Phone code could prevent your phone from illegal use. The default phone code is 0000. Please change it to your own as soon as possible.

Text

Operation

Your phone offers text input modes: abc. Abc. ABC. 123, eZi and Symbols.

Method

Change input mode	Press the # Key to select another text mode, press the * Key to enter the symbols mode.
Input Letters	In the abc/Abc/ABC mode, press corresponding letter key till the letter appears.
Input Words	In the eZi mode, press any key once to key in any word. Predictive text input is based on a built-in dictionary. When you have finished writing the word and it is correct, confirm it by pressing the OK Key. If the word is incorrect, press the Up key or Down key to view other matching words found in the dictionary.
Input Digits	In the 123 mode, press digit key once.
Input Symbol	Press the Navigation keys to switch symbols and press corresponding digit key. Or press the 1 key till the symbol (common symbols) appears except for the 123 mode.
Input Space	Press the 0 key , except for the 123 mode.
Move cursor	Press the Navigation keys.

Basic Function

- Add Name: Add a new contact to your phone or UIM card.
- All List: View all contacts in all list, press the Left key or Right key to view different groups. In all list, you can search for a contact by entering the key words, press the **OK Key** to view the details. Select **Option** to do more operations.
- Groups: View/edit groups and set group ringer.
- Speed Dial: View speed dial list and you can set speed dial. In standby mode, press and hold the number key to dial the corresponding call.
- Memory Status: View Number of entries saved and maximum number of entries capacity in phone and UIM

New Message: Send a new message to other mobile

Messages
