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Quick Start Guide

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Introduction

ZTE MF60 is a 3G/2G mobile hotspot device, working in GSM/GPRS/EDGE/ 5. External WCDMA/HSPA/HSPA+ network. The client devices could connect to it via USB Antenna or Wi-Fi interface. The device supports data and SMS services, enabling you to communicate anytime and anywhere.



Hold the Power button to switch on/off the device.	
It is where you insert the memory card (microSD card).	
This button is used to start/end Wi-Fi Protected Setup	
authentication process and enable/disable the Wi-Fi	
function.	
Hold it for 3 seconds to activate the WPS function.	
When the WPS function is available, press it to	
deactivate the WPS function.	
Press it to enable/disable Wi-Fi function.	
Press it twice continuously to display the current SSID	
and Wi-Fi password on the screen.	

Hardware Installation

Inserting SIM Card and Battery

Switching On/Off Your Device

Hold the **Power** button to switch on/off the device.

Pull the microSD cover gently out of the card slot.

- The plug only fits one way. Do not use excessive force to insert the plug.
- Make sure the plug is the right way round and lined up correctly. Insert it gently.



Working Mode

Your device supports three working modes. For the client, we only use PC or laptop as the example in this document.

USB Mode: Connect to the device with the USB cable.



Wi-Fi Mode: Connect to the device via Wi-Fi

Via Wi-Fi

- Power on your device directly. It will take 1~2 minutes to initialize.

Mixed Mode: Connect to the device with the above two connection methods. Notes: You need to check your Wireless Network Connection. Set the client to obtain an IP address automatically in the Internet protocol (TCP/IP) properties, and the client will get an IP address like "192,168,0,100".

Accessing the WebGUI Configuration Page

- Check your internet settings to make sure no proxy servers are defined.
- 3. Launch the internet browser and enter http://192.168.0.1 or http://m.home in the address bar. And you can also double-click on your desktop to

access the page.

It is recommended that you use IE (7.0 or later), Firefox (3.0 or later), Opera (10.0 or later). Safari (4.0 or later), Chrome (10.0 or later).

View the information of WAN, WLAN and Device, Input the case-sensitive default password "admin", and then click Login to access the WebGUI Configuration

- Do not put anything on the top of your device. Do not lay devices to overlap each other when using.
- The device takes 1~2 minutes to initialize, and attach to the network

PIN Code Verification

If the PIN code of your SIM card is enabled, you will need to input the PIN code when you login at the first time.



Sleep Mode

In anyone of the two conditions below your device will enter the sleep mode:
