### Explanation for phone with/without UIM card Key instruction


There are two types of ZTE CDMA mobile phone, one needs Key UIM card inserted and another does not need. Sections or functions in this guide are for the phone with UIM card. If your phone could be used without UIM card, please pay attention to the following items:

- . The phone can be used without the UIM card.
- 2. Some functions are only available concerning with UIM and won't display, such as:
- The new contact can be saved only in Phone, not in UIM
- The message(s) in Inbox can not be moved to UIM card.
- There is no PIN Lock function in Security Setting



- 3. When the charging animation on the screen stops, the charging is completed. The charging takes usually up to 2~3 hours. During charging, it is a normal phenomenon that the battery, phone and charger may get hot.
- 4. After the completion of charging, disconnect the charger from the phone and AC socket.

## Keypad Lock

If you want to unlock the keypad, please press first the Right soft kev. and then the \* kev.

If the call is coming when the keypad is locked, you can press the Call key to answer.

When the keypad is locked, calls may be possible to the official emergency number programmed into your device.

- Speed Dials: View speed dial list, and you can set speed dial. In standby mode, hold the number key to dial the corresponding call.
- Memory Status: View Number of entries saved and maximum number of entries capacity in phone and UIM card.

New Message: Send a new message to other mobile phones' number. The message could be send to multi-Other Facility receivers. See "Text" for more instructions of writing text and character. Select Option to insert contact details and

message template when you edit a message.

- Inbox/Drafts/Outbox/Sent: Read messages in Inbox/Drafts/ Calendar: View calendar and schedule events. Outhox/Sent

- Message Template: Some common used message preformatted in phone. You can edit or send them. with service provider.
